CHRISTMAS TIME IN NEW YORK CITY

7 Days - 6 Nights

The sample itinerary described below is approximately like the one your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 Depart from Missouri and travel to your overnight stop for lodging (pack an ovemight bag); dinner is on your own in the area.
- Day 2 After breakfast, check out and travel to New York City and Herald Square to shop and visit at one of New York City's most famous icons of shopping ... Macy's, the world's largest department store. There will be time to visit Rockefeller Center, New York City's historic landmark for dining and shopping in the heart of Midtown Manhattan. No trip to Rockefeller Center is complete without seeing the skating on the rink, one of New York City's most celebrated attractions. Set amid a sparkling scene featuring the annual Christmas Tree, it's something everyone should experience. There are many shops and other restaurants to visit in the area. Dinner has been arranged for you in Manhattan this evening. After dinner, travel to New Jersey where you will check into your hotel for a four-night stay.
- Day 3 Following breakfast, board your motorcoach for Radio City Music Hall where you will enjoy a back door tour of the theater. Get behind the scenes of over 70 years of New York City history. See the great stage, the art deco interiors, the legendary Wurlitzer organ, and even meet the Rockettes themselves. After the tour, enjoy lunch on your own in the area and some shopping along Fifth Avenue. Then, it's off to Radio City Music Hall to see the Christmas Spectacular featuring the world-famous Rockettes, who have been performing at Radio City since 1932. Dinner has been arranged for you this evening.
- After breakfast, you will travel to Battery Park at the lower end of Manhattan where you will board the Day 4 Statue Cruise Ferry. Cruise to Liberty Island where you will visit the Statue of Liberty. The Statue was an international gift of friendship from the people of France to the people of the United States. Your enhanced visit will include an audio tour which will guide you through the unique history of Liberty Island from its time as a fort through the construction of the Statue of Liberty and its establishment as a national monument. You will also visit the new Statue of Liberty Museum. The Museum features three interactive galleries (the Immersive Theater, the Engagement Gallery, & the Inspiration Gallery) that tell the statue's history in thought-provoking ways. Each gallery is designed to inspire visitors. After your visit, board the ferry and cruise to Ellis Island, a landmark which symbolizes America's immigrant heritage. The Museum is designed as a self-guided museum with three floors of audio/visual displays and exhibits detailing the history of the immigration process from 1912 to 1954. Your enhanced visit will include an audio tour through all three levels of the historic Main Building while allowing you to vividly relive the immigrant experience through first hand immigration accounts. View the Wall of Honor which lists the names of the immigrants that arrived on Ellis Island. Board the ferry to return to Battery Park. This evening's dinner will be at one of Manhattan's Deli restaurants.
- Day 5 Enjoy breakfast, then check out and meet your guide for a tour of Lower Manhattan which will encompass a diverse and exciting cityscape and a patchwork of distinct neighborhoods, including Times Square, Greenwich Village, Little Italy, Chinatown, Ground Zero, and the Financial District. Enjoy lunch on your own, followed by a visit to the 9/11 Memorial Museum and shopping in Chinatown. Dinner has been arranged for you this evening.
- **Day 6** Following breakfast, check out and depart for your overnight stop for lodging. Check into your hotel (pack an overnight bag) and prepare for dinner on your own this evening.
- Day 7 After breakfast, check out and depart for home with lasting memories of your trip to the "Big Apple".
