Arrive in Sedona with time to explore the town or join the *optional* fun-filled Pink Jeep tour that takes you to an amazing 2000 feet to the top of the Mogollon Rim. Your afternoon drive takes you through winding Oak Creek Canyon on your way towards the Grand Canyon National Park, carved over millions of years by the Colorado River, considered one of the seven natural wonders of the world. DAY 3, Grand Canyon, Lake Powell

A memorable day awaits to explore the South Rim of the Grand Canyon with its unrivaled awe-inspiring views and breathtaking beauty.
