Itinerary

Day 1 - Sunday, August 17, 2025

Begin your journey with a comfortable motor coach ride to the eclectic Dr. Evermor Sculpture Park in North Freedom, WI. Marvel at larger-than-life scrap metal creations in this quirky outdoor museum before heading to a delightful dinner. Steeped in history, this charming restaurant in Mazomanie takes you back to the mid-1800s. Conclude the day checking in to your hotel.

Day 2 - Monday, August 18, 2025

A hot breakfast is included each morning of your tour. Today, venture east to Manitowoc to explore the Wisconsin Maritime Museum and tour the WWII submarine USS Cobia. Following lunch in Two Rivers, enjoy a scenic drive along Lake Michigan's shoreline before arriving at Door 44 Winery for a delightful wine tasting experience. After a Swedish-inspired lunch at the popular Al Johnson's Swedish Restaurant, famous for Goats on the Roof, embark on a boat tour along the shores of Green Bay, featuring views of the Eagle Bluff Lighthouse. Conclude the day with a traditional Door County Fish Boil. Relax at your hotel this evening.

Day 4 - Wednesday, August 20 2025

Step back in time on the Lighthouse Trolley Tour, visiting Door County's iconic lighthouses and enjoying a scenic ride. A box lunch is included to keep you energized. Later, explore the arts, galleries, and shops in Egg Harbor Village, before returning to your hotel for a relaxing evening with dinner included at your resort in the Kona Bay Fish House. Retire to your rooms at your leisure.

Day 5 - Thursday, August 21, 2025

Take a ferry ride to Washington Island, passing through "Death's Door" strait. Explore the island with a narrated tour, visiting the Stavkirke Church and Schoolhouse Beach. After returning to the mainland, enjoy some free time in Fish Creek Village for dinner and shopping on your own, at your leisure.

Day 6 - Friday, August 22, 2025

Visit to Cave Point County Park for stunning views & hiking along Lake Michigan. Visit Renard's Cheese to sample Wisconsin's finest cheeses. End your day with a beer tasting and dinner at one of Milwaukee's favorite historic restaurants.

Day 7 - Saturday, August 23, 2025

Wrap up your tour with a visit to the House on the Rock, a fascinating architectural marvel filled with unique collections and displays. Explore this quirky attraction before departing for home.
