MONTREAL & QUEBEC CITY

6 Days - 5 Nights

The sample ltinerary described below is approximately like the litinerary your group will be following during your stay with WHITE STAR TOURS. However, the exact times, days, and destinations may vary for your group.

- Day 1 Depart from your hometown and travel northward to your overnight stop for lodging (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own this evening.
- Day 2 Following breakfast, check out and continue traveling northward just a few miles north of America's Canadian border to the exquisite French-Canadian Province of Quebec ... an area steeped in European culture and proud of its French, British, and Native American heritage to Lunch/rest stops on your own will be made along the way. Upon arrival in Montreal you will meet your local guide who will welcome your group and conduct an orientation. After checking into your hotel, depart for a delicious dinner at a popular restaurant in the area.
- Day 3 After breakfast, meet your guide for a morning City Tour of Montreat, which will take you past Place Ville-Marie, the Olympic Stadium, Mont Royal, St. Joseph Shrine, and many other sites. After the tour, arrive at Montreaf's Underground City where you can have lunch on your own and do some holiday shopping. Afterwards, return to your hotel to freshen up before departing for dinner at another popular restaurant.
- Day 4 Breakfast, then depart for a visit to the Notre Dame Basilica in the historic district of Old Montreal. Discover the history of Montreal's mother church from the origins of the city's colony to the imposing neogothic church of today. Walk through the nave and aisles as you admire the stained glass windows, the artwork and the interior decor, which is carved, painted and glided with gold leaf. It was raised to the rank of minor basilica by Pope John Paul II in 1982 and designated a National Historic Site of Canada in 1989. Its religious, historical and artistic importance makes it a treasure of Quebec's heritage and one of the most visited sites in Montréal. After your visit, you will spend the rest of the day visiting Montreal's Christmas Markets where you can grab some lunch on your own and visit the kiosks that sell a variety of items including gourmet foods and artisan gifts as well as many other Christmas gift ideas. Shops include gourmet markets and Later, you will depart for another restaurant where dinner has been arranged for you this evening.
- Day 5 Following breakfast, check out and depart for your overnight stop where lodging has been arranged for you this evening (pack an overnight bag); dinner is on your own in the area.
- Day 6 Enjoy breakfast, then check out and depart for home with lasting memories of your visit to Montreal.
